# UPDATED RATE NOTICE AND SOME REMINDER INFORMATION ABOUT GARBAGE PICK UP

#### SOLID WASTE COLLECTION RATE

Effective with the November, 2020 billing each Single-family Residential Connection will be \$13.65 per month per unit. This charge is billed with the water line item.

The District has contracted with OFS Solid Waste Services to provide for trash collection. For garbage information or complaints, the customers may contact OFS - Solid Waste Services directly at 281-457-2705

OFS Solid Waste Services will provide curb-side pick-up. Curb side pick-up is defined as any location upon the lot or yard of the residence which is within 2-4 feet of the roadway.

### Wednesdays and Saturdays are regular trash pick-up day, with only one bulk item for pickup on Saturdays.

No barrels allowed, please use a standard 40-gallon trash can with a 40-pound maximum weight capacity. This will consist of household trash and lawn waste produced from the residence

and not from outside business or locations, in bags or trash cans, limited to two (2) containers per residence. For normal collection; branches and tree trimming must be bundled and placed at the curb; not to exceed four (4) feet in length and eighteen (18) inches in diameter for each piece and weight not to exceed more than forty (40) pounds per bundle. All trash should be placed at the curbside by 7:00 am on collection day. Late put-outs are not considered misses.

#### Saturday's bulk trash pick-up day.

Bulk trash is defined as, large or bulky household items or trash which is generated by ordinary maintenance of a household but too large for containers including, but not limited to furniture, mattresses, dishwashers, grills, etc. which are capable of being lifted into a truck by two persons.

Contractor shall not be required to pick up junk cars, engines, air conditioners with fluids, refrigerators with fluids, tires, large tree trunks, debris from construction, roofing material, or remodeling material or other junk or trash that requires special handling without prior arrangements and pricing pre-set between homeowner or resident and OFS Solid Waste Services on an individual quote basis. Contact OFS Solid Waste for schedules and prices.

If a major holiday falls on your garbage collection day, your pickup will occur on the next scheduled collection day. Scheduled holidays are: Thanksgiving Day and Christmas Day.
